We also plan to have hot teas, apple cider and hot chocolate. Several cold beverages will also be available including sun tea, lemonade (or both), and ice coffee. As you are generous in sharing your home baked or store bought goodies we will gladly offer these additional treats to enjoy together. (By the way, be sure to read the sign inside the door and ask me about where the name Cafe Lydia comes from).

The shade structures are complete, adding both shade and a beautifully welcoming ambiance to our patio. It is a joy to be the family of God fellowshipping together in this space.

Selbo Hall has been painted, outfitted with new lights and carpet and the sound is much improved with the addition of acoustic panels on the ceiling. It is much easier to hear speakers and one another. Gordon and Elsie Selbo would love to see us together encouraging one another and sharing in God's Word together. We continue to live in the legacy of God's servant leaders.

We have also recently upgraded lights in Cafe Lydia, B1 and the Carter Great room. B1 and the Carter Great room also benefited with the installation of acoustic panels.

The journey continues as *we hope* to move forward with a new kitchen to be completed in early 2025, along with a bathroom refresh across the hall from the kitchen.

We are also developing plans to recreate Children's ministry space in C1-3. This will also mean the development of one of our D classrooms into a music room for Choir and Bells.

God has blessed us richly with wonderful property and facilities and we are doing our best to be good stewards of these gifts, using them to strengthen and grow this community rooted in Christ's love and grace and growing in our knowledge of His Word.

FROM OUR TREASURER, CHRIS COLLIER

St. Timothy's continues to be off to a great start in 2024. Our offerings and other income

fell short of our budget by \$23,306. Offerings have dropped which is typical during the months of May – August. In May, we received a restricted donation for Chapa in the amount of \$49,480 that funded their Dairy Farm \$27,608, an additional 9 children \$4,872 & for their CarePoint \$17,000 and for Dream House \$5,000 that were all paid out in May. A \$50,000 restricted donation for note reduction was received and will be paid out in June.

BUDGETSEREPORT

We continue to operate prudently and with sound oversight of our spending. The favorable budget to actual expenses in May was mainly due to preschool continued success, delay in new hires and timing of expenses.

DEADLINE TO APPLY JULY 12

We are pleased to announce that St. Timothy's Lutheran Church is again offering scholarships to recent high school graduates. Scholarship recipients will receive \$1000 toward college tuition and fees, with payment made directly to the student.

ELIGIBILITY FOR SCHOLARSHIP AWARD

The following criteria must be met to qualify for scholarship award under the program:

- 1. The applicant must be affiliated with an NALC congregation within the Central Pacific Mission District or an LCMC congregation in Northern California.
- 2. The applicant must have graduated from high school within the past two years and be planning to start his or her post-secondary education during 2024.
- 3. The applicant may not have previously received a scholarship under the program.
- 4. The applicant must return an application package (application form, an attached essay, a copy of the acceptance letter or proof of admittance from the school, and a letter of reference).
