We are beginning a new season and God's continued blessings are on the horizon. What an amazing blessing it is to know we live with God's promises, grace and blessings. As we at St. Timothy's go about our ministry, we hope to bring glory to God in all things. As I write this, we are about to celebrate our combined worship and Ministry Fair. In recent years we have sought to make adjustments to strengthen these ministries in St. Tim's Kids (Sunday School), Messy Church, MOPS (now MomCo) and our Preschool. You may be aware and even have participated in our movement to create new/renewed Children's ministry space as we renovate the space in C1-C3 and the nursery. Our hope is to demonstrate the value we place on our young families and children and to strengthen our service to them.

We know full well that the ministry to children happens first and foremost in their own families and we seek to support that in ever more effective and creative ways. The selection of C1-C3 goes well beyond that it was in minimal use. The reality is that we wanted to move this ministry closer to the sanctuary and make it more visible. We have also already moved the sign-in for the children to the courtyard where we also host our 1st Sunday Family brunch on the playground.

It is our hope that families know they are valued at St. Tim's and that both parents and children experience the blessing of belonging and being in community here.

Living in the covenant of our Baptism, we grow in faith, love and obedience to God. This faith, love and obedience are very often the conduits that God uses to pour out his hope, blessings and peace in our lives and the lives of our little ones. We want to do all we can to let them know and regularly remind them that they are loved by and belong to the family of God, his Church.

As you consider the gifts that God has given you, explore your own heart felt desires for where you would choose to use those gifts. Please consider how you might be a part of our ministry to the families, youth and children. We have an opportunity to bless them in and through our ministries.

Our offerings continue to come in lower than our budgeted levels as has been the

case for most of this year. The shortfall has been somewhat mitigated by greater levels of income we have earned on our investments.

We continue to operate prudently and with sound oversight of our spending, which has resulted in being favorable to our budget throughout this year.

Our preschool is starting this new school year with less students than was planned. We have seen an increased interest in families wanting to enroll their children and hope to increase our numbers in the coming month.


