This month we are approaching Easter Sunday, the day when we remember and celebrate the resurrection of Jesus, our Risen Lord, who has conquered death, sin and the power of the devil and set us free, giving us new life, abundant life, and eternal life through Him! But before Easter Sunday itself comes Holy Week. Holy Week is the time in the Church calendar where we walk with Jesus from His Triumphal Entry on Palm Sunday, through the Last Supper, the Crucifixion, and the tomb, before ultimately getting to Easter Sunday.

As Holy Week approaches this year, I want to give you a devotional set of Bible Readings that you can use that week to journey with Christ through that final week of his life. And as you go through this week of Bible readings, I want to encourage you to keep one important thing in mind... everything that he did that week, he did for you.

Palm Sunday- The Triumphal Entry Luke 19:28, John 12:12-19, Psalm 2

Monday- The Authority of King Jesus
Matt. 23:23-32, Mark 12:28-34, Luke 20:1-19 Ps. 110

Tuesday- Jesus Teaches in the Temple Courts Matthew 21:12- 22:45, Mark 12:28-34, Psalm 1

Wednesday- Jesus Anointed at Bethany Mark 14:1-11

Maundy Thursday John 13:1-17, Matthew 26:17-30

Good Friday Luke 22:39-23:56, Isaiah 53

Saturday Matthew 27:62-66, Psalm 34

Easter Sunday Matthew 28

During this Holy Week, set apart a special time not just to spend time reading these Scriptures, but also to pray: before you read, that God's living and active word would touch your heart and pierce your soul with its power, and after you read, that God's Spirit would use His word to tell you of His incredible love *for you*, revealed through the life, death, and resurrection of His Son, Jesus Christ, the Risen Lord!

REMODEL PROJECT 2025 PLEDGE CAMPAIGN

In an email and a postal mailing last month, we shared that the kitchen/bathroom/parking lot remodel was approved at the March 16 meeting. The project can only move forward pending raising \$250,000 in pledges in 30 days. Every gift, regardless of size, will help us to reach our goal.

Lunch Bunch does need to know how many are coming, so please call Betsy Grandey at (408) 629-6093.




